#### SHORT-TERM MISSIONS TRIPS

6-Day (Tuesday through Sunday) Life-Changing Experiences for Youth Across the U.S.

Goal: Participants will grow in their relationship with Christ, gain a better understanding of God's heart for the poor and oppressed, and return home with ideas about how they can impact their own community. Trips focus on four areas – service, compassion, discipleship, and racial reconciliation.

What's Included: Components of The R3 Workshop (Biblical racial reconciliation training), a 40-hour poverty simulation, housing, meals, ministry supplies, teaching, ministry activities, and handbooks to prepare participants for the trip.

Price: Starts at \$425 per person, group rates available.

#### **URBAN PLUNGE**

Weekend or one-day missions trips full of hands-on ministry and training for effective outreach in your community.

Goal: Participants will gain valuable missions experience, help transform the lives of families in Milwaukee, and learn new ways to reach their own communities.

What's Included: High-impact training, participation in community outreach, service activity, housing, meals, and cross-cultural worship experience (Weekend Plunge only).

Price: Weekend Plunge (Friday-Sunday): \$100 per person. One-Day Plunge (Friday-Saturday): \$75 per person.

#### **POVERTY SIMULATIONS**

## Experience the obstacles and realities of living in poverty in urban America.

Price: \$150 per person. \*Minimum 20 participants.

#### **FAMILY TRIPS**

# Opportunity for the whole family (including children in grades 1-5) to serve, learn and grow together.

Goal: Our Short-Term Missions Trip is adapted for families to grow in service, compassion, discipleship, and racial reconciliation. Trips are Wednesday night through Sunday afternoon.

What's Included: Meals, housing at City on a Hill, teaching, ministry experience, and any supplies needed.

Price: \$250 per person.

What's Included: Meals and housing.
